Stewart O'Nan's award-winning fiction includes *Snow Angels, A Prayer for the Dying, Last Night at the Lobster,* and *Emily, Alone. Granta* named him one of America's Best Young Novelists. His new novel, *West of Sunset,* published in January of this year, is a portrait of F. Scott Fitzgerald's last years in Hollywood.
